Next Sunday, October 1st, is Respect Life Sunday. While many respect life ministry initiatives address abortion, respect life also includes the terminally ill, handicapped, impoverished, neglected and marginalized. As we approach Respect Life Sunday this year, we must also include in our prayers and efforts - peace in our streets and an end to racism and bigotry. In their *Pastoral Plan for Pro-life Activities* the U.S. Catholic Bishops wrote, "Only with prayer - prayer that storms the heavens for justice and mercy, prayer that cleanses our hearts and souls - will the culture of death that surrounds us today be replaced with a culture of life."

Respect Life Sunday will be the first Sunday of the month, and, as is our habit, we will have Eucharistic Adoration after Mass until 12:30 pm. Why not plan to spend a little extra time in prayer with us as we pray that "the culture of death that surrounds us today be replaced with a culture of life."

The fifth precept means that the faithful are obliged to assist with the material needs of the Church, each according to his own ability.

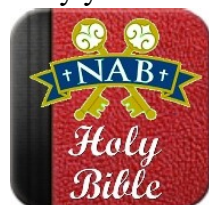
“What We Have Seen and Heard”

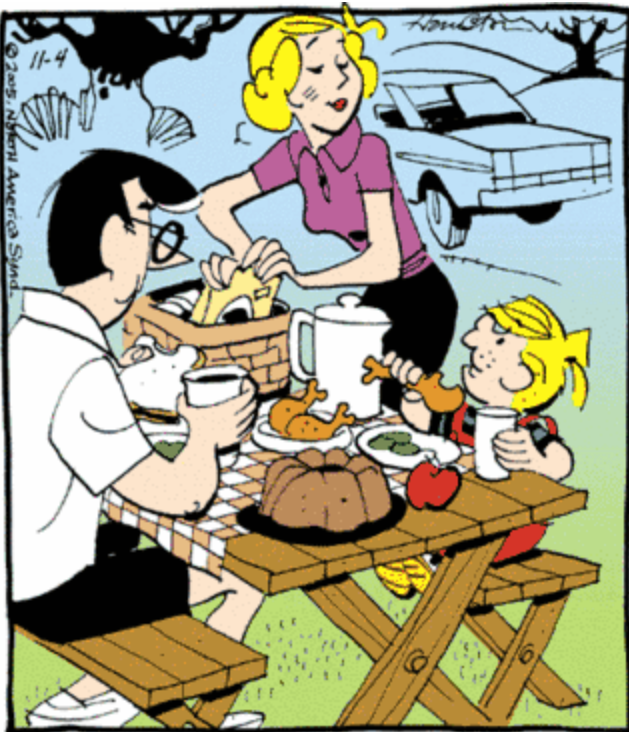
