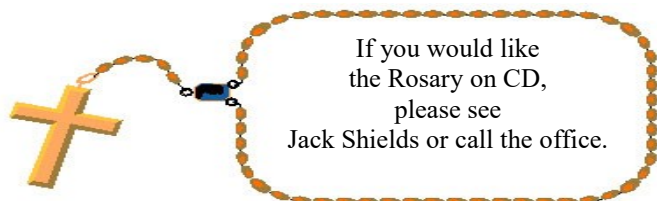
What is freedom?

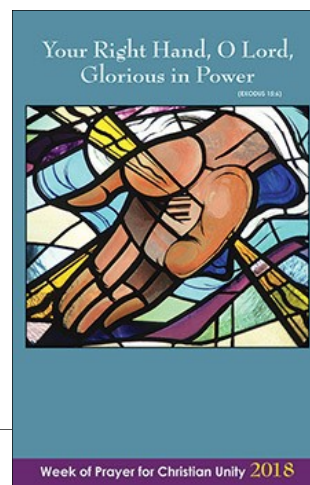

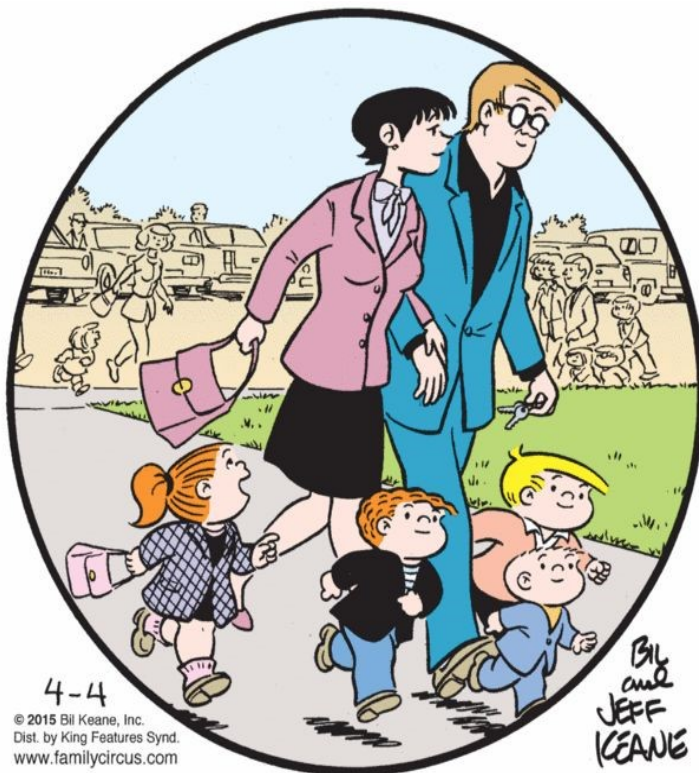
