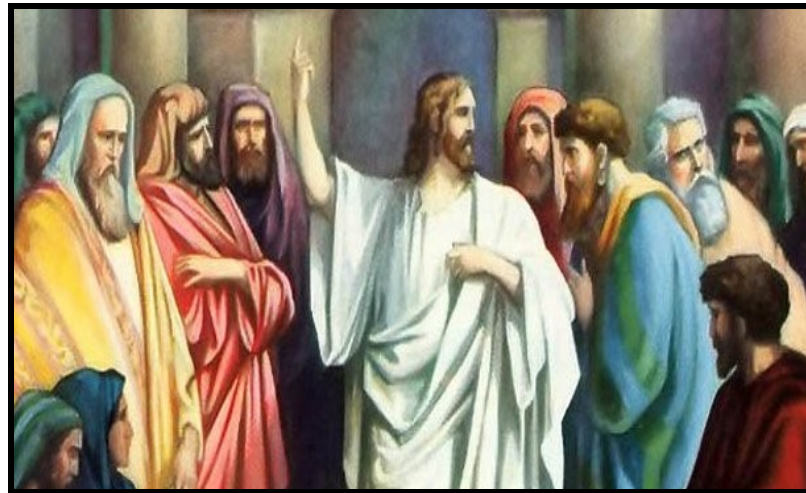

From the Deacon's Bench...

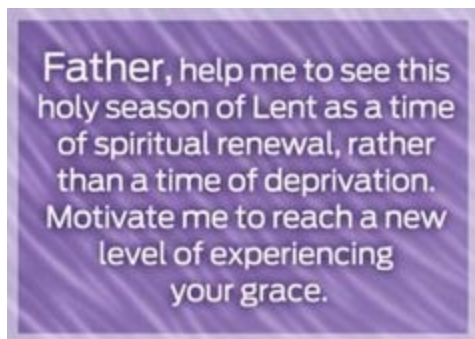
Brothers and Sisters,

Prayers & Practices of the Church

The Rosary

The Rosary is a Scripture-based prayer. It begins with the *Apostles' Creed*, which summarizes the great mysteries of the Catholic faith. The *Our Father*, which introduces each mystery, is from the Gospels. The first part of the *Hail Mary* is the angel's words announcing Christ's birth and Elizabeth's greeting to Mary. St. Pius V officially added the second part of the *Hail Mary*. The Mysteries of the Rosary center on the events of Christ's life. There are four sets of Mysteries: Joyful, Sorrowful, Glorious, and – added by Pope John Paul II in 2002 – the Luminous.

The repetition in the Rosary is meant to lead one into restful and contemplative prayer related to each Mystery. The gentle repetition of the words helps us to enter into the silence of our hearts, where Christ's spirit dwells. The Rosary can be said privately or with a group.

April 20, 1938: Born in Jasper, IN

August 15, 1963: Solemn Profession as a Benedictine monk

May 3, 1964: Ordained a priest

1971: President-Rector, School of Theology, Saint Meinrad Seminary

1982: President-Rector, Saint Meinrad College, while continuing as President-Rector of Saint Meinrad School of Theology

January 16, 1987: Appointed Third Bishop of Memphis

March 2, 1987: Ordained and Installed Bishop of Memphis

July 14, 1992: Appointed Fifth Archbishop of Indianapolis

September 9, 1992: Installed Archbishop of Indianapolis

1995: Co-moderator of the Disciples of Christ-Roman Catholic International Dialogue

2003: Consultor to the Vatican's Congregation for the Clergy

September 21, 2011: Pope Benedict XVI Accepts his Retirement

January 25, 2018: Dies at Saint Meinrad Archabbey
