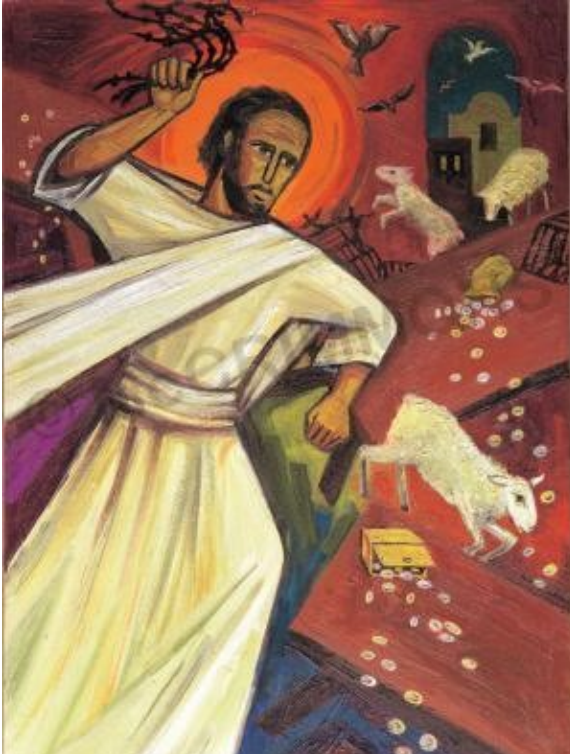

This Thursday, February 22, at the Celebrating Catholic Schools Values event, Ody Oruche received a Career Achievement Award for his years of service to Catholic Schools both here and at Chatard and to the archdiocese at large. Ody has also served on the archdiocesan finance council. He continues to chair our finance council. Congratulations and thank you, Ody!

As I've mentioned during announcements, the charter school which leases our school building will close at the end of this school year (June 8<sup>th</sup>). The Mayor's Office revoked the charter due to academic and financial difficulties. of the Church**

**Going to Confession**

1. You always have the option to go to confession anonymously or face-to-face.
2. After the priest greets you in the name of Christ, make the sign of the cross. He may choose to recite a reading from Scripture, after which you say: "Bless me Father for I have sinned. It has been (*state how long*) since my last confession. These are my sins."
3. Tell your sins simply and honestly to the priest. You might even want to discuss the circumstances and the root causes of your sins and ask the priest for advice or direction.
4. Listen to the advice the priest gives you and accept the penance from him. Then make an Act of Contrition for your sins.
5. Through the power of the Holy Spirit, the priest will absolve you of your sins.
6. Spend some time with God thanking and praising Him for the gift of His mercy. Try to perform your penance as soon as possible.

**Reminder**

On two Sundays, March 11 and 18, we will be placing the rocks we put outside last year in front of the altar. On Good Friday these rocks will be used to construct the tomb of our Lord. Our lives will be placed at the tomb expressing our love, our sorrow, and contrition. We ask Jesus to please forgive and remember us along with the good thief as we strive to do better.
