From the Deacon's Bench...

Brothers and Sisters,

So, who's working on being a saint? Hopefully, we all are. During this Easter Season and really all the time that should be our goal. Through our baptism we each became part of the Communion of Saints, but we still need to put some work in. So, how to go about it? Could we use some suggestions? Well, Pope Francis has recently given us an apostolic exhortation entitled *Gaudete et Exsultate* that will help.

Pope Francis tells us that his document is not meant to be a "treatise on holiness, containing definitions and distinctions helpful for understanding this important subject, or a discussion of the various means of sanctification." The "modest goal" of the pope "is to re-propose the call to holiness in a practical way for our own time, with all its risks, challenges and opportunities." And he shares his hope that his "pages will prove helpful by enabling the whole Church to devote herself anew to promoting the desire for holiness."

Gaudete et Exsultate isn't overly long. It has five chapters. The starting point is "the call to holiness" made to all. From there he goes on to identify "two subtle enemies" that tend to lead us down the wrong path as we seek to grow in holiness. Then Pope Francis gives us the Beatitudes as a positive model of holiness in following the way "in the light of the Master" in a practical way. He goes on to describe some characteristics of holiness in our present world: patience and meekness, humor, courage and fervor, community life and constant prayer. The exhortation closes with a chapter dedicated to the spiritual life as "combat, vigilance and discernment."
