From the Deacon's Bench...

Brothers and Sisters,

The feast of our parish patron, St. Andrew the Apostle, falls on November 30th. The practice in our archdiocese is for parishes to celebrate their patron saint's feast on the Sunday before or after the feast, but for us that is impossible. The Sunday before is the Feast of Christ the King and the Sunday after is the First Sunday of Advent. Last year, we used the readings and prayers for his feast when we celebrated our parish's 70th anniversary. This year we will celebrate St. Andrew's feast next Sunday. So... a little bit about good St. Andrew.

St. John's Gospel presents Andrew as a disciple of John the Baptist. When Jesus walked by one day, John said, "Behold, the Lamb of God." Andrew and another disciple followed Jesus. "Jesus turned and saw them following him and said to them, 'What are you looking for?' They said to him, 'Rabbi (which translated means Teacher), where are you staying?' He said to them, 'Come, and you will see.' So they went and saw where he was staying, and they stayed with him that day." St. Andrew was St. Peter's brother, and in John's Gospel we find, "He first found his own brother Simon and told him, 'We have found the Messiah'* (which is translated Anointed). Then he brought him to Jesus. Jesus looked at him and said, "You are Simon the son of John; you will be called Cephas" (which is translated Peter). St. Andrew is often referred to as the "First Called" because of this. St. Andrew is mentioned a few more times in the Gospels. Before the multiplication of the loaves, it was Andrew who spoke up about the boy who had the barley loaves and fishes. When the Gentiles went to see Jesus, they came to Philip, but Philip then brought them to Andrew.

Tradition has it that St. Andrew preached the Good News in what is now modern Greece and Turkey and was crucified on an X-shaped cross where he continue to proclaim the Gospel until he died.
