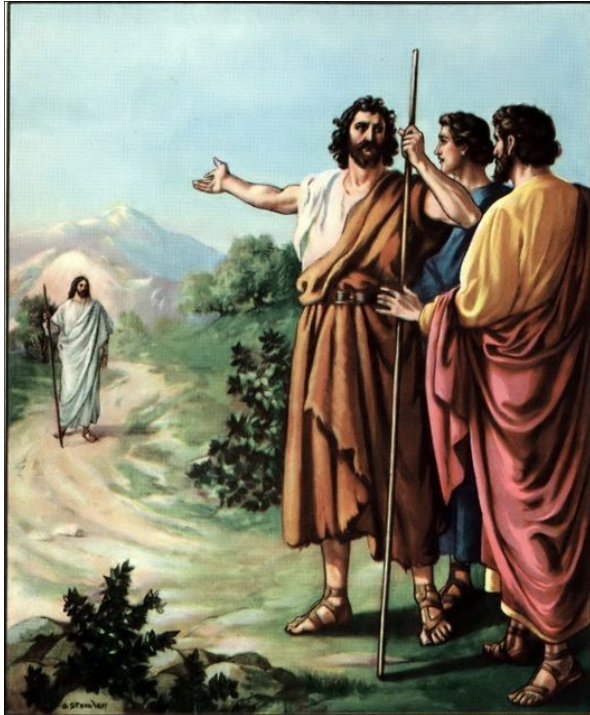

From the Deacon's Bench...

Brothers and Sisters,

At 6:01pm, April 4, 1968, Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. was fatally shot as he stood on a second story balcony at the Lorraine Motel in Memphis, Tennessee. It's been almost fifty years.

Tomorrow, we will celebrate Martin Luther King Day. The celebration of Dr. King's birthday became a national holiday in 1986, and this year falls on the actual date of his birth.

So, have we realized Dr. King's dream? Unfortunately, I believe that our answer must be "Not yet!" So, what are we to do? Well, rather than simply observing tomorrow as just another national holiday, maybe another day off work, or as another day with no mail delivery and such, let's make the time to inform ourselves on the issues that stand in the way of Dr. King's dream. Let's look for ways to act. Yes, it's been fifty years, and it may take another fifty years. (I pray that it doesn't.) But, for those who will come after us, let's continue the work. We may not see our actions bear fruit, but as Dr. King wrote, "Life's most persistent and urgent question is: What are you doing for others?"

On another note we will have Adoration after Mass next week (January 21). Monday, January 22, is the forty-fifth anniversary of the Roe vs Wade decision and the Day of Prayer for the legal protection of the unborn. Please consider making the time to pray that our nation will come to respect all life from conception to natural death.
